



General Data Protection Regulation (GDPR)

The following data protection information gives an overview of the collection and processing of your data.

With the following information, we would like to give you an overview of how we will process your data and of your rights according to data privacy laws. The details on what data will be processed and which method will be used is described in the following steps:

1. What Sources and data do we use?

The data that we collect is explicitly or implicitly given by the user, player or the involved Federation.

2. What do we process your data for (Purpose of Processing) and on what legal basis?

Your data is exclusively processed for own technical use: Invitation, Newsletters to your address, inscriptions to sports events, ranking position and other technical internal use.

3. Who Receives My Data?

The event organizations for the duration of the event, for statistical and archive purposes.

4. Will data be transferred to a third country or an international organization?

No. Your data remains in our data base for internal use only.

5. For how long will my data be stored?

Your data is stored for a limited period during the event to which you participate. The sportive results are processed and stored for statistical purposes only.

6. What data privacy rights do I have?

Your privacy rights are not affected by your implicit authorization for data registration.

7. Am I Obligated to Provide Data?

As the world Governing Body for Carom Billiards, UMB keeps a database of its members, partners, sponsors, referees and players for internal use only. By participating into UMB events you implicitly agree with the registration of the data that you provided.

8. To What Extent Is There Automated Decision-Making?

We do not use automated decision-making in our processes.

9. Will Profiling Take Place?

No profiling takes place other than the Players biography, World records, championships and World Cup Medal Winners

10. We do not collect any biometric data from you.

Information on your right of objection according to Article 21 of the General Data Protection Regulation (GDPR)

1. Right to Object to Data Processing for Direct Marketing Purposes.
In individual cases, we process your personal data to conduct direct marketing. You have the right to object to the processing of your personal data for this type of marketing at any time. This also applies to profiling, insofar as it is in direct connection with such direct marketing. If you object to processing for direct marketing, we will no longer process your personal data for this purpose.
2. Individual Right of Objection On grounds relating to your situation.
You shall have the right of objection, at any time to processing of your personal data which is based on Article 6 paragraph 1 subparagraph e of the GDPR (data processing in the public interest) and Article 6 paragraph 1 f of the GDPR (data processing based on balancing interests). This also applies to profiling based on this provision in terms of Article 4 No. 4 of the GDPR.

If you submit an objection, we will no longer process your personal data unless we can give evidence of mandatory, legitimate reasons for processing, which outweigh your interests, rights, and freedoms, or processing serves the enforcement, exercise, or defense of interests. Please note, that in such cases we will not be able to provide services and maintain a sports relation.
