### **A. World Ranking Events & Points applicable from January 1<sup>st</sup>, 2019**

#### **1. Latest UMB World Championship:**

1 <sup>st</sup> Place	120 Points
2 <sup>nd</sup> Place	81 Points
3 <sup>rd</sup> & 4 <sup>th</sup> Places	57 Points
5 <sup>th</sup> to 8 <sup>th</sup> Places	39 Points
9 <sup>th</sup> to 16 <sup>th</sup> Places	24 Points
17 <sup>th</sup> to 32 <sup>nd</sup> Places	12 Points
33 <sup>rd</sup> >	8 Points

#### **2. Latest Confederation Championship:**

1 <sup>st</sup> Place	80 Points
2 <sup>nd</sup> Place	54 Points
3 <sup>rd</sup> & 4 <sup>th</sup> Places	38 Points
5 <sup>th</sup> to 8 <sup>th</sup> Places	26 Points
9 <sup>th</sup> to 16 <sup>th</sup> Places	16 Points

#### **3. Latest National Championship:**

Confederations and National Championships will be valid for a maximum of two past sports seasons.

### **B. World Cup No-Show Penalties:**

1. Qualification Rounds: A no-show player will receive (-8) points as a penalty, unless he presents a valid excuse accepted by the UMB.

2. Main Tournament: A no-show player will receive (-16) points penalty, unless he presents a valid excuse accepted by the UMB.

**C. Ranking Position:**

1. Should 2 or more players have equal total ranking points before any event, and following this event they still have equal total ranking points, the player in front will remain ahead of the other player or players.
2. Should 2 or more players have different total ranking points before any of the above events listed in (A) that result in equal total ranking points, the player that was behind prior to this event will move ahead of the other player or players.

The present rules are reviewed by the UMB board and are applicable from January 1<sup>st</sup>, 2019.
